<p><b>Tuesday:</b>  <b>Read:</b> A book and discuss the following question:            What does this book remind you of?  <b>Word Work:</b> Words for this week are: <b>kicked, mail, rain, sister.</b> Write the words 3 times each with crayons.  <b>Write:</b> Write me a quick email letter telling me about your Easter weekend.  <b>linda.tulloch@nbed.nb.ca</b></p>	<p><b>Tuesday:</b>  <b>Skip Count:</b> *Skip count by 2s starting at 0 going to 100. Repeat. Can you beat your time?  <b>Calendar:</b> Read today's date. Ask: How many more days in April are there?  <b>Number Work: Introduce subtraction on a number line. <p><b>Wednesday:</b>  <b>Read:</b> A book. If you could ask the main character one question, what would it be?  <b>Word Work: *Mix and Fix:</b> the words: kicked, mail, rain, sister with letters.  <b>Write:</b> Write two or three questions you can ask the main character in the story.</p>	<p><b>Wednesday:</b>  <b>Skip Count:</b> Count by 5s to 125. Repeat.  <b>Calendar:</b> Read today's date. Record the weather for the day.  <b>Number Work:</b> Solve the following subtraction questions on an open number line.            a) 59 - 36 = ____      c) 72 - 43 = ____            b) 80 - 47 = ____      d) 99 - 18 = ____</p>
<p><b>Thursday:</b>  <b>Read:</b> A non-fiction book or list. Tell one interesting fact you learned from the book.  <b>Word Work:</b> Table write the following words: kicked, mail, rain, sister.  <b>Write:</b> Write three interesting facts about yourself.</p>	<p><b>Thursday:</b>  <b>Skip Count:</b> *Back from 100 by 1s. Repeat.  <b>Calendar:</b> Read today's date. Record today's weather.  <b>Number Work:</b> Solve the following using an open number line. A) Cohen found 20 Easter eggs. He ate 7 of them. How many eggs does he have left? B) Olivia found 36 Easter eggs. Rowan found 27 eggs. How many more Easter eggs did Olivia find?</p>
<p><b>Friday:</b>  <b>Read:</b> A book. How do you think the character is feeling? How can you tell?  <b>Word Work &amp; Writing:</b> Write a sentence for each of the following words: kicked, mail, rain, sister.</p>	<p><b>Friday:</b>  <b>Skip Count:</b> Back from 100 by 5s. Repeat. Did you beat your time?  <b>Calendar:</b> Read today's date. Say the days of the week. Record today's weather.  <b>Number Work:</b> Solve with an open number line.  <b>A)</b> 56 - 38    B) 61 - 17    C) Mrs. Tulloch is 53 years old. Ella-Jade is now 8 years old. How much older is Mrs. Tulloch than Ella Jade?</p>

\***Skip Counting:** When a skip counting activity requires a lot of numbers such as counting by 1s, or by 2s it is okay for you to help your child with the count. You can count around the circle, where each member

of the family takes a turn saying the number that comes next in the sequence. Counting by 5s and 10s should be done mostly independently.

**\*Word Work: Mix and Fix:** Ask your child to spell the words using paper letters or magnetic letters. Once they have made one word, mix the letters up and have them make the same word again.
